Become a UL Sign Manufacturer

Learn how you can manufacture signs under the General Coverage Program

Learn how you can become a certified sign manufacturer with UL under the General Coverage Program in four easy steps:

Step one

Sign up through our Sales Support portal at: LightingInfo@ul.com.

Step two

A quote will be generated for acceptance which starts you on your way.

Step three

Your manufacturing location will be visited by an UL Follow Up Services Inspector who will give you an orientation on the General Coverage Program.

General Coverage Program is a UL program for clients that manufacture signs by the UL 48 Standard, where the certification is included in the Underwriter's Laboratories follow up program.

Step four

UL provides each manufacturer with a 13 Module training program that was specifically designed to take you through all the paragraphs of the standard, making you and your employees ready to apply the UL mark. Once you have passed this stage you will go into the ongoing Follow Up Services process.

Follow up services process

In order to verify the maintenance of integrity of the signs you are manufacturing, UL follow up inspector will be visiting your facility a minimum of four times per year or more based on the number of signs you manufacture. This inspector will look at your whole process to ascertain the signs are being manufactured to the UL 48 standard.

Why choose UL:

- UL ensures their marks represent the highest integrity by preventing counterfeiting.
- UL's works with Energy Efficient government bodies to verify your product will comply.
- UL's regulatory services team works with Authorities Having Jurisdiction to maintain safety as a primary aspect of locations where all signs hang.

- UL maintains a certification directory, where anyone looking for a UL sign manufacturer can go to easily locate your establishment.
- UL can provide you with the most current standards for LED, LED retrofit.
